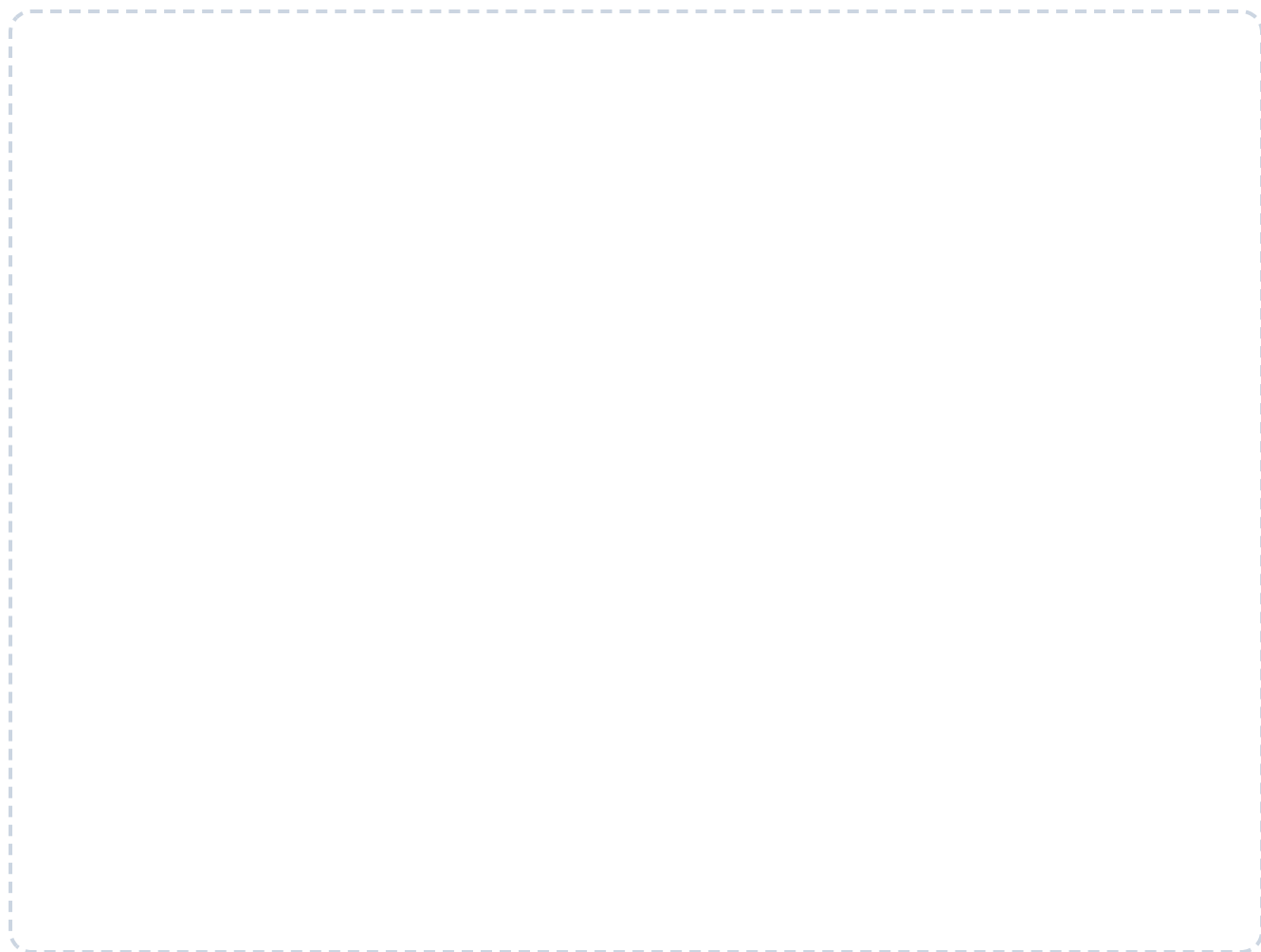

About this verse
